Role Description

We're looking for a passionate, hands-on Deputy Bar Manager to help lead the day-to-day running of our two licensed bars in Edge Hill Students' Union's stunning new three-floor venue. The space includes a ground-floor bar, a first-floor bar, and a spectacular rooftop terrace for pop-up bars during special events.

You'll be joining a supportive, friendly, and ambitious team in one of the most beautiful university campuses in the UK, working to create memorable experiences for our vibrant student community, as well as university staff, local residents, and external guests. It's a welcoming and inclusive space where a diverse student community can connect, feel safe, and be themselves.

The Union is also home to our merchandise shop (*Gear*), arcade zone (*Tilt*), pool zone (*Side Pocket*), and games hub, along with a commercial space (*Glam*) offering 'rent-a-chair' opportunities to local businesses, plus the Students' Union team offices.

Our Students' Union is more than just a place to grab a drink, it's a year-round destination hosting everything from student nights and live music to conferences, private functions, and large-scale celebrations. Your role will be key to shaping its success and atmosphere.

Main Responsibilities

- Support the Bar Manager in overseeing the daily operations of both licensed bars and the rooftop pop-up bar during events.

- Assist with rotas, recruitment, onboarding, and staff development.
- Manage stock control, cellar operations, and ordering in a cashless environment.
- Uphold licensing regulations, health and safety standards, and hygiene protocols.
- Champion safe space initiatives, such as "Ask Angela," and enforce Challenge 25.
- Ensure bar spaces are clean, safe, and welcoming at all times.
- Work collaboratively with the Bar Manager, Commercial Performance Manager, and other SU teams to deliver a varied calendar of events.
- Adapt to a diverse customer base, from students and academics to local residents and conference delegates.
