The full allocation of £100 would allow two of our committee members (Secretary and Treasurer) to complete their Level 1 teaching Spanish Diploma through the Open University at a cost of £30 each. The remaining £40 would be used to purchase a group ticket for the whole societies entry to the touring 'Spanish History' Exhibition which will be at Liverpool Museum which we will be visiting next month on 17/11/2021.

Please tell us in detail what your society members would gain from the above.

By funding two of our committee members to complete their level 1 Teaching Spanish Qualification this will allow us to hold more teaching sessions as we will no longer be limited to 1 qualified committee member. As well as great personal development and skill enhancement for both those individuals being able to complete the award, this will have a positive impact on the whole societies development. We have received a lot of interest from students who cannot currently attend our weekly session due to other commitments so being able to hold sessions three times a week would allow us to welcome more members. Having three qualified committee members will also allow us to work in smaller groups within sessions to enhance the experience of all members and potentially run different level group breakouts such as 'beginner' and 'advanced'. We hope this will help January and April Cohorts not feeling like they are not too late to start.

The opportunity to attend the 'Spanish History' exhibition at Liverpool Museum will develop our members understanding of Spanish Culture and provide context to many of our sessions. Some of the sessions which we will attend during our trip will also be a great opportunity to network with other groups which we hope will build on our sense of community and open further opportunities. The grant will help remove the barrier of ticket cost as anyone attending will still have to fund transport to the event.
